TEACHING EXPERIENCE

The image courses cover the following techniques: paper transfer, mono-printing on clay, silkscreen, decal design and printing, traditional ceramic decoration techniques, life-drawing on clay. The majors' course is (currently) 17 separate independent studies. The current crop of majors make functional, sculptural and installation work. Instruction includes kiln firing as well as clay and glaze chemistry.
2011- PRESENT Pots On Wheels (POW!) founding potter and instructor. Design and execution of workshops of varying lengths with schools, nursing homes, and afterschool programs, as well as public projects on the street in cities from Boston to Kansas City, MO.
