Statement

I am fascinated in how the language of art can create a bridge between the past and present. How composition can come together to create an aesthetic distinctiveness. My interests lie with the interrelationship and engagement between the materiality and structure of objects. Looking upon shape as an embodiment of process and material. It is fascinating how the nature of simply insignificant objects can come together to create a juxtaposition, sparking new relationships between two or more objects. I am absorbed by the reactive nature of process and how it creates a two-way conversation between artist and material. How the relationship of matter, texture and surface complement form and how the act of making through process creates meaning and significance. I am interested in exploring and creating art from a subconscious instinct, a raw urge to withdraw oneself from mind to physical rendition and rendition to form. My approach is empirical in nature and draws on my experiences and observations, this is where I create and respond to material intuitively. For myself objects have individual presence, yet when they exist collectively dialogue can become more complex which in turn extends narrative.
